

Jan Pruim

Short Biography:

Prof. Pruim has been involved in the development of positron emission tomography from the early nineties of the last century. His focus is on the use of PET in oncology and in brain diseases. He was involved in standardisation of PET procedures, was vice-president of the Dutch Society of Nuclear Medicine, dean of ESMIT and member of the EANM Board, and chair of the EANM working group on AI.

Abstract:

Compared to other medical disciplines AI has not yet gained a lot of ground in nuclear medicine. Which opens opportunities to learn from the experiences made elsewhere. In the position paper the EANM sets the basics for the development of AI in nuclear medicine and formulates preconditions.
