Short Biography:

Irène Buvat is a physicist who has been involved for more than 30 years in the development of quantification methods in emission tomography. She is currently the director of the Inserm Laboratory of Translational Imaging in Oncology at the Research Center of Institut Curie, Orsay, France. She is a strong advocate of reproducible research and leads the development of the LIFEx software for radiomics.

Abstract:

ChatGPT is an artificial intelligence chatbot that uses natural language processing to answer questions and compose various written content, including articles, social media posts, essays, code, and emails. This presentation will discuss whether there is room for such chatbots in Nuclear Medicine, what they could be used for, and will review the performance that have already been reported in the literature.
